



ROBERT K. BRAYTON

Dr. Robert K. Brayton is the Cadence Distinguished Professor of Electrical Engineering and Computer Sciences at UC Berkeley. He obtained his Ph.D. in Mathematics from MIT in 1961. Renowned for his pioneering work in logic synthesis and electronic design automation (EDA), Dr. Brayton’s research has profoundly influenced the development of integrated circuits and digital systems. He has authored over 450 papers and several seminal texts in the field. Among his numerous accolades, he received the IEEE Emanuel R. Piore Award and the ESDA/CEDA Phil Kaufman Award. A distinguished member of the National Academy of Engineering, Dr. Brayton’s contributions extend to leadership roles in multiple EDA startups and collaborations with industry giants like Cadence Design Systems, IBM, Intel, and Synopsys. His dedication to advancing technology continues to inspire and shape the future of electronic design.
